- Analyzing Sales Forecast at sku level and performing maintenance in demand solutions forecasting module;
- Quarterly Production and Inventory Planning for the Ukiah Fence Line and Sawmill Production;

 - Provide Inventory Position Projections at sku level;
 - Provide reports of Finished Goods Inventory and Work In Progress;
